



ETF WORKS

The methodological note concludes that :

no single methodology can capture the diversity of key aspects of skills mismatch, and

a combination of methods is recommended to help countries exploring as many dimensions as possible,

taking also into account data availability and analytical capacities, as well as country specific dimensions of skills and employment.

STEPS OF THE PROJECT

- Preparing list of indicators and template of database
- Data collection and calculations of skills mismatch
- Drafting country reports by national experts
- Drafting country factsheets and cross-country synthesis
