 Law on Labour Migration adopted on April 1 2015, entering into force on November 1 2015;

- The Government Resolution N 417 adopted on August 7 2015 on approving the "Rule on Employment by a Local Employer of a Labour Immigrant and Performance of Paid Labour Activities by such Immigrant", entering into force on November 1 2015;
- In 2015 the Government of Georgia launched a labour market components' research for studying employers' attitude/demand and shortages in professions.





- Strengthening cooperative links between the country of origin and the receiving country, expanding networking opportunities, sharing skills and knowledge;
- Develop Diaspora Financial Literacy programs for Remittances and Diaspora Investments;
- Supporting Diaspora Entrepreneurship MoU between the Office of the State Minister for Diaspora Issues and the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) was signed;
- The participants envision cooperation in the following areas:
  - Facilitating Participation of Migrant Georgians in Commercial Farming;
  - Facilitating the Development of Women-owned Agribusinesses;
  - Organizing a Joint Event, "Established Agriculture Enterprises as Role Models";
  - Establishing a "Pilot Commercial Village";
- Temporary return of qualified nationals (TRQN-II) IOM-Georgia;
- Online school
