

# Torino Process 2018-2020

**Title of the event:** Torino process 2018-2020 kick-off meeting in the Republic of Belarus

## SUMMARY

The Torino Process is an evidence-informed analysis of Human Capital Development issues and VET policy responses in the ETF partner countries. The process, launched by the ETF for the first time in 2010, enters in its fifth round of implementation that will be completed in the period 2019-2020.

The Republic of Belarus has participated in the Torino process since 2010 and has taken a full responsibility of the Torino process and produced the report through self-assessment. The 5<sup>th</sup> round of the Torino Process builds on this high level of ownership with a view further improving the scope and usefulness of the Torino Process.

The objectives of this meeting are the following:

- To reflect on the added value and relevance of Torino Process in Belarus;
- To get familiar with the Torino Process 2018-20 objectives and strategic orientations;
- To present and familiarise with the Torino Process National Reporting Framework - NRF (framework of analysis) and the ETF assessment;
- To define the implementation of the Torino Process in Belarus (calendar, stakeholder involvement, sub-national dimension).
