HISTORY OF THE NQF

2005 - Georgia joined the Bologna process

2006-2009 - Project of Higher Education Qualifications Framework (was not approved)

2010 - National Qualification Framework was approved

Describe the qualifications of higher, professional and general education

2015 - With the wide involvement of stakeholders the NQF analysis process has begun

2017-2018 - Legislative amendments were made

And

renewed National Qualifications Framework was prepared

REVISED LAWS

Law of Georgia On the Educational Quality Enhancement

- Defines the basic terminology of the framework;
- Formulates the framework objectives;
- Creates the basis for development of rules and procedures for NQF management and monitoring processes;
- Creates the basis for development Qualifications Electronic Registry .

Law of Georgia on Higher Education

- Stating compliance of higher education qualifications with the NQF levels;
- Creates the basis for development of the new, bachelor's (180 ECTS) and master's (60 ECTS) programs development.

Law of Georgia on Vocational Education

- Stating compliance of vocational education levels with the NQF levels;
- Creates the possibility for recognition of informal and non-formal education at all levels of vocational education

Law of Georgia on General Education

Stating compliance of general education levels with the NQF levels

Basic - NQF level 2

Full General - NQF level 4

GQF OBJECTIVE

- Classifying qualifications by observing the following key principles of the NQF:
 Compatibility of learning outcomes, quality assurance, access to information, related to qualifications;
- Connecting, governing and developing general, VET and higher education;
- Supporting Life-Long Learning –LLL;
- Promoting quality assurance system;
- Ensuring compatibility, comparability and transparency of qualifications at an international level;
- Facilitating mobility;
- Facilitating recognition of formal education, obtained during a study period;
- Facilitating recognition of non-formal education;
- Informing public about existing qualifications;
- Reflecting constantly-changing requirements of society in Education system and stimulating description of relevant, renewable qualifications for the system.

NQF Structure

- unified structure of education (General, VET, High) subsystems;
- 8 levels- described by learning outcomes/descriptors;
- Level 1- the lowest, initial level;
- Level 8- the highest, ultimate level;
- The level descriptor is general, neutral and does not refer to any field of education or occupation;
- The level descriptor is a minimal threshold of learning outcomes and is not exhaustive;
- The level descriptor is a basis for formation of an educational standard or/and program learning outcomes.

Governing and Monitoring of the National Qualifications Framework

Regulations:

Law of Georgia on Development of Quality of Education, Article 243

The rule on Governing and Monitoring the National Qualifications Framework

Governing bodies:

National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement; NQF Advisory Board

Monitoring of the National Qualifications Framework

Ongoing, annual monitoring

Objective - Facilitating performance of tasks, stipulated by the annual action plan

Periodic, comprehensive monitoring

Objective - Supporting the NQF further development;

Terms: at least once in 4-5 years;


Specially formed group;

Approved plan.

The Electronic Registry of Qualifications

Objective of the registry:

- Ensure publicity of information about the qualifications included in the NQF;
- Provide assistance to students, pupils to make an informed decision about desired qualification and ways of obtaining education;
- Provide assistance to employers to define necessary qualifications for operations, as well as to select relevant training or/and re-training programs for their employees;
- Facilitate recognition of Georgian qualifications abroad through accessibility of comprehensive and trustworthy English-language information.
