## **SUMMARY**

The Torino Process is an evidence-informed analysis of Human Capital Development issues and VET policies responses in the ETF partner countries. The process, launched by the ETF for the first time in 2010, enters in its fifth round of implementation that will be completed in the period 2019-2020.

Jordan participated in the Torino process since 2010.

The objectives of this first workshop are the following:

- To get familiar with the TRP 2018/19 objectives and strategic orientations;
- To present and familiarise with the TRP National Reporting Framework NRF (framework of analysis) and clarify any questions on the NRF;
- To present the ETF assessment;
- To discuss and agree on policy added value of TRP in the country and define/confirm the calendar of implementation;
- To present and discuss the TRP indicators, see if there are any gaps and how to collect additional information;
- To discuss and agree on relevant key stakeholders to be involved in the preparation and consultations on the NRF.

The working languages of the event will be Arabic and English.


