SUMMARY

The Torino Process is an evidence-informed analysis of Human Capital Development issues and VET policies responses in the ETF partner countries. The process is in its fifth round of implementation that will be completed in 2020.

Following the discussion of the national report in January, this workshop will have the primary objective to present and discuss key challenges and recommendations, from the ETF perspective. It will also offer an opportunity to share the results of a tracer study carried out with 21 VET schools and centres of competences and discuss the issues of data and information availability in the field of education and training.

Specific objectives of the workshop are the following:

- Share and discuss the results and recommendations from the ETF Tracer Study in initial vocational education and training in Kosovo and issues of data availability in education and training
- Present and discuss key challenges of the Kosovo VET system as they emerge from the ETF analysis under the Torino Process
- Share next steps of the Torino Process, including actions at regional and international levels

The expected outcome is an agreed understanding of strategic orientations of and recommendations for the Kosovo VET system.
