SUMMARY

The Torino Process is an evidence-informed analysis of Human Capital Development issues and Vocational Education and Training policies responses in the ETF partner countries. The process is in its fifth round of implementation that will be completed in 2020.

Following the discussion of the national report in March 2019, this workshop will have the primary objective to present and discuss key findings, recommendations and modalities and/or conditions for their implementation.

Specific objectives of the workshop are the following:

- Share the final findings on the main issues and challenges faced by the VET system
- Discuss the proposed recommendations
- Identify and agree on first steps or implementation modalities to address the recommendations

The expected outcome is to inform the strategic orientations for the development of the Montenegrin education and training system and the forthcoming VET strategy design for the period 2021-2024.

The event forms part of the European Vocational Skills Week, which showcases vocational education and training; and vocational skills through a series of events, exhibitions and other initiatives across Europe.
