SUMMARY


The Torino Process is an evidence-informed analysis of Human Capital Development issues and VET policies responses in the ETF partner countries. The process, launched by the ETF for the first time in 2010, enters in its fifth round of implementation that will be completed in the period 2019-2020.

Following the launching of the Torino Process in Jordan, in March 2019, this event will focus on the presentation the key findings of the **first draft of the national report** with the objective to review the information and evidence collected and identify any gaps, reach a consensus on the key findings.

The objectives of this workshop are the following:

- Share with participants the findings of the first draft of the National Report (based on NRF);
- Collect input from participants to identify (if relevant) additional information;
- Discuss and agree on the next steps for the finalisation of the National Report.

The expected outcome is a revised version of the National report.


