*Torino Process 2018-2020 Online Dissemination Workshop: Key findings and recommendations resulting from the ETF assessment Kazakhstan, 26.06.2020*

### Background

*The Torino Process is an evidence-informed analysis of Human Capital Development issues and VET policies responses in the ETF partner countries. The process, launched by the ETF for the first time in 2010, enters in its fifth round of implementation that will be completed in the period 2019-2020 in Kazakhstan.*

*This online event was a great success with over 50 national and regional stakeholders, and European Commission, international organisation representatives in attendance.*

### KEY OUTCOMES/CONCLUSIONS

*The findings of the ETF assessment were largely discussed and the identified recommendations were highly appreciated by the national authorities and VET representatives. It has also been agreed to disseminate the Torino Process report in 3 languages: Kazakh, Russian and English.*
