SUPPORTING SCHOOLS FOR LEARNING IN THE DIGITAL AGE- SELFIE KICK-OFF IN UKRAINE ONLINE MEETING

LOCATION 20 APRIL 2021 12.00-16.00 KYIV TIME ZOOM

SUMMARY

Ukraine has in the recent years taken initiatives to support the digital transformation and development in the country, for example, the Cabinet of Ministers has approved the Concept Paper on Digital Skills Development; the Ministry of Digital Transformation has published the Digital Skills Framework for Citizens, as well the on-line platform [Dija:Digital Education](#), promoting the development of digital skills of teachers, parents, public servants, etc.; The Ministry of Education and Science has launched the [All-Ukrainian School On-Line, e-Day Books and e-Record Books](#), published the Guides for Distant and Blended Learning to support remote teaching and learning practices and thus to foster the use of digital technologies in education and training.

In this context and in line with the co-operation framework agreed between Ukraine and the European Training Foundation¹ (ETF) for 2021, the aim of this event is to launch a SELFIE² pilot in a number of schools in Ukraine to enable the school's self-assessment and further strategic planning of digital transformation accordingly.

SELFIE³ is a tool developed by the Joint Research Centre of the European Commission⁴ that aims to support the innovative use of digital technologies in teaching and learning in primary, secondary general and vocational schools, and digital competences of learners.

SELFIE guides schools in a self-reflection process involving school leaders, teachers and students on how they could integrate and effectively use digital technologies for teaching, learning and student assessments. The SELFIE questionnaire explores eight areas, namely leadership, infrastructure and equipment, continuing professional development, teaching and learning, assessment practices, network & collaboration, support & resources and the digital competence of students. Results are collected in a paper-free, interactive report.

At system level, SELFIE offers, through anonymous, aggregated data, an overview of the digital readiness of the school system in Ukraine.

The objectives of the workshop are:

- Launching a SELFIE pilot in Ukraine, involving primary and secondary general and vocational schools selected by the Ministry of Education and Science in Ukraine;
- Explain the SELFIE pilot process at school and system level, including how to interpret and apply the results.

Train the school coordinators and two other representatives from each participating school on how the SELFIE tool can be set up and used in their school. This event and the subsequent results of the SELFIE pilot will inform the Ministry of Education and Science in Ukraine in partnership with the Ministry of Digital Transformation on further steps with a possible system-wide piloting of SELFIE and towards the digitalization of K12 and VET schools in Ukraine.
