



The TPACK framework

Students needs to be actively involved






THE SELFIE TOOL – KEY INFORMATION

- Launched in October 2018

- Aim: effective use of digital technology for teaching and learning driven by pedagogy
- What: survey for schools for different respondent groups, school leaders, teachers and students, it covers 8 areas. Online tool ensuring anonymity
- **How**: guiding a school throughout a self- reflection process, outcomes based on a set of questionnaires

REVIEW OF THE SELFIE PILOT RESULTS – SYSTEM LEVEL

Quantitative Analysis

- Analysis of anonymized aggregated data

Qualitative Analysis

- Case studies
- Analysing user groups' perception (e.g., focus groups)

Directing resources based on analysis outcomes from **audit** (e.g., external evaluation) and **perception of schools** (SELFIE)

SELFIE INTEGRATION IN WIDER DIGITAL EDUCATION POLICIES – SYSTEM LEVEL

- Linking to European and international initiatives, Erasmus+
- Linking to Quality Assurance
- Multi-level Digital Education strategy, top-down and bottom-up







SELFIE GOVERNANCE STRATEGY – SYSTEM LEVEL

- Governance model, the SELFIE national coordinator already in place
- Involving stakeholders, based on a **regular run of SELFIE**, for innovation and quality of digital and online learning
- Adopting a clear and effective communication strategy







SELFIE INTEGRATION IN CPD – SYSTEM LEVEL

Professional development for

- Teachers and SELFIE school coordinators
- School leaders
- Professional development for designing, implementing and monitoring the **SELFIE-based** school's digital strategy and development plan

ANNUAL REVIEW CYCLE – SYSTEM LEVEL

- Regular run of SELFIE,
- During a suitable period of the school year, on voluntary basis
- **Festival** of digital and online learning and innovation in teaching and learning










PILOT OF SELFIE IN A SCHOOL IN AZERBAIJAN - TIMELINE

REGISTRATION OF A SCHOOL ON THE SELFIE PLATFORM



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How can I set up and manage SELFIE in my school?

- Sign-up
- Select educational level
- Set-up questions (mandatory, optional, ownquestions)
- Select dates for the survey (school mangers, teachers and students)
- Activate and send links

TIMING OF THE SELFIE EXERCISE

How long is the survey open?

- •2 weeks (communicated to invitees)
- •3 weeks (in the SELFIE system)

How long does it take?

For school leaders and teachers: some 40 minutes
For students: some 20 minutes

However, the questionnaire must be completed within **two hours of starting**





SELECTS WHO WILL TAKE PART

Teachers

above 500 teachers

- Who should be involved?
- School leaders: head principal and teachers in a coordination role
- Teachers: at least one year in service
- **Students:** aged 9 or over (primary school)
- How many for each respondent group?
- Minimum participation rate see guidelines

Number of eligible teachers per education level	% minimu
Up to 10 teachers	80%
11-30 teachers	60%
31-45 teachers	50%
46-125 teachers	33%
126-200 teachers	25%
201-500 teachers	20%

CUSTOMIZE THE SELFIE SURVEY AND ITS LAUNCH



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> The survey

- Core statements
- Optional statements
- Your own statements (up to 10)
- Launch of the survey
- Upon the generation of links. Once done, no further changes
- Monitoring in real-time





SHARE AND DISCUSS THE RESULTS

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The SELFIE report includes per **area** and per **question** in **anonymised form**:


- An overview of the completion rates
- Results overview;
- Results per area;
- Results per user group;
- **Comparative analysis** among the latest two run of SELFIE

The report is accessible only to the school running SELFIE

RATIONALE FOR USING SELFIE



Empowering schools through collective selfreflection

- Building self-reflecting communities of learning
- Providing a common reference framework for schools to frame learning with technology
- Helping schools define their priorities
 and action plan

- Resource investment decisions driven by learning needs
- Identifying professional development needs
- Assessing and monitoring the quality and availability of digital learning resources

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Projecting national policy, collecting school data and sharing best practice


- Quality assurance
- Framing the national picture
- Sharing best practice for digital transformation




