Services linked to social inclusion and equity under the ETF Network of Excellence (Re-launch)

Authorising department: Project Management Tools and Dissemination Unit

Deadline for expression of interest: Still open for interested tenderers

Launch date: 9 July 2021

Budget: 60,000€

Scope of the procedure:

Excellence in Social Inclusion is the aim of the assignment. This will be achieved through the establishment of a Community Practice Platform whose members will participate in a peer review exercise which will identify relevant practices and strategies to be shared with CoVES in further developing and contributing to skills for inclusion development.

More specifically, the project aims at sharing and consolidating the innovative inclusion practices, activities and practices developed at local level by the partners to further exploit their outcomes and impact on Inclusive Excellence.

Through this support, the ETF partner countries CoVEs will be assisted to seize the opportunities for enhanced visibility, collaboration, and support. In its planned support, ETF aims to provide CoVEs' members with opportunities to cooperate with other CoVEs that operate within European Member States as well as among themselves- the specific focus is on skills for inclusion. The Partnership will collect and share practices and tools of VET centres companies and business representatives, universities, and policymakers from partnering countries.

Through this thematic and contractual support, ENE's members will establish partnerships through peer exchange/learning and more importantly co-developing models that can be replicated in different contexts. These partnerships will be based also on the profiles and prioritised needs of the CoVEs members. As a start the focus will be on:

- establishing Community Practice Platform, in the context of EPALE¹ as a way of collaborative working with focus on peer reviews of participating CoVEs mainly their practices and development responses in vocational and education training programmes
- working with the interested CoVEs to identify development needs, share practices, design tools and create partnerships on existing and new practices on how to overcome exclusion/boost inclusion of young people in acquiring skills for work and life.
- learning from each other and to address their own development by co-working together.
- flagging up how the members can take forward some joint concrete actions (Action Plans) for boosting skills for inclusion and cohesion.

- experience in developing CoVEs institutional capacities through development actions
- experience in innovative approaches in developing and implementing policies and tools for social inclusion
