

TITLE OF THE PROCEDURE:

Services on Greening Responses to Excellence through Thematic Actions (Re-launch)

Authorising department: Project Management Tools and Dissemination Unit

Deadline for expression of interest: still open for interested tenderers

Launch date: 22/07/2021

Budget: 60,000€

Scope of the procedure:

The main objective of the requested service is to support ETF in setting-up and facilitating a peer learning partnership in the thematic area 'Going Green', in particular, greening of teaching and learning.

The partnership will enable CoVEs to learn from one another and to address their own development collaboratively through thematic actions.

The selected contractor is asked to design and facilitate the implementation of a peer review of participating CoVEs on their green responses in vocational and education training programmes, to support CoVEs in elaboration of Action Maps (Coves will produce the Action Plans with the support of the Contractor) for development, to provide recommendations and actions for peer learning and to facilitate thematic peer learning actions.

The present tender aims to conclude a contract with a service provider for:

1. Analysing the context in which CoVEs are implementing green skills and identifying different dimensions supporting greening responses in VET.
2. Facilitating a peer review among a selected group of CoVEs addressing operationalization and practical experiences in implementing green skills, considering its different operational and conceptual dimensions.

3. Providing a comparative assessment based on outcomes and lessons learned from the CoVEs' practices addressing barriers and enablers as well as the benefits and added value of green skills programmes.
4. Supervising CoVEs' Action Maps for enhancing their excellence in greening responses to education and training
5. Facilitating peer learning actions among the CoVEs for progress and further development of CoVEs.
6. Coordinating communications among CoVEs taking part in the peer learning events, including sharing progress on relevant practices and learning, during the lifetime of the assignment.

Identifying and propose action recommendations and further strategies for policy learning to support CoVES contributing on green skills development, in concrete, focusing on policy options for ETF PCs.

Type of contract: Fixed contract service in phases

Selection criteria - technical and professional capacity requested to the economic operator:

Experience in implementing similar services to those described in the tender specifications related to green skills in the previous three years.
