SUMMARY

The peer review process in the GRETA project is almost concluded, with only one peer review still remaining. Originally, and as announced earlier, this meeting should have concluded the peer review process. Participants were to reflect on the outcomes of the process and the implications for their own 'going green' action plan.

However, as a result of the current situation in Ukraine combined with the fact that out of the 14 CoVEs participating in the peer review meetings, eight are from Ukraine, the GRETA team has decided to refocus the meeting. Consequently, discussions about the outcomes of the peer review process will be delayed to a later stage. Instead, this meeting will have a twofold purpose:

- 1. To discuss, based on expert input, the concept of green skills and how CoVEs can approach the provision of green skills
- 2. To discuss topics for the six thematic meetings that will take place between May and October.
