*Review of policies for lifelong learning in Georgia:

SUMMARY:

Georgia is an active participant in the new round of the Torino Process, which the European Training Foundation (ETF) has launched with a specific focus on monitoring the performance of education and training systems in a lifelong learning perspective, and on reviewing policies for lifelong learning.

This event will present and discuss the results of Torino Process monitoring of policy and system performance of VET in Georgia, and it will launch the Torino Process review of policies for lifelong learning in Georgia, which will focus on adult education.

The meeting will have the following objectives:

1. Present the monitoring results for Georgia;

3. Identify stakeholders (institutions) for a reference group which will oversee the review process;
