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STATUS AND ROLE OF CENTRES OF VOCATIONAL EXCELLENCE (CoVEs)

- Centres of Vocational Excellence are high-potential VET institutions empowered to organise vocational training programmes at different levels, including integrated programmes.
- They hold additional responsibilities in building the systemic capacity of VET institutions.
- They are mandated to enhance the capacity of CoVEs to fully perform their functions, including technology transfer and innovation activities.

Post-secondary and nontertiary post-secondary vocational education and training and secondaryvocational education and training

Training at ISCED levels 3, 4 and 5

- Centres of Vocational Excellence were established in 2015.
