

DAY 3, IMPLEMENTATION

Instruction for group work

Objectives of the session

The session has three main objectives:

- Refine the knowledge gained over the past two days.
- Gain a deeper understanding of how impact evaluation can be implemented in real-life situations.
- Plan the practical implementation of the lessons learned.



Group work

We will work in two rounds, each lasting 30 minutes. Here is how we will divide during the first round:

- **Table 1 and 2:** Planning of randomized evaluation
 - *Table 2: Focus on fragile context*
- **Table 3 and 4:** Implementation of randomized evaluation
 - *Table 4: Focus on fragile context*
- **Table 5-7:** Dissemination and utilization of findings
 - *Table 7: Focus on fragile context*

Focus on any specific features or issues related to fragile contexts, such as safety, availability of data, sensitivity of some issues, limited access to project participants, etc.

Group work

Here is how we will divide during the first round:

- **Table 1 and 2:** Implementation of randomized evaluation
 - *Table 2: Focus on fragile context*
- **Table 3 and 4:** Dissemination and utilization of findings
 - *Table 4: Focus on fragile context*
- **Table 5-7:** Planning of randomized evaluation
 - *Table 7: Focus on fragile context*

Focus on any specific features or issues related to fragile contexts, such as safety, availability of data, sensitivity of some issues, limited access to project participants, etc.

Group work – how we work

- For each topic, the group will identify a few key challenges (between 3 and 5).
- Each challenge will be written down on a separate big post-it and placed on the wall.
- For each challenge, the group will identify a set of possible, practical actions and solutions.
- Focus on actions and solutions that can be actually implemented in your organizations. Try to be as specific as possible.
- For each action, define, if possible:
 - Who is responsible
 - How long it can take to implement it
 - What you would need to implement it
- It's better to prepare a few, more elaborated actions or solutions.
- Each group will identify a rapporteur who will briefly present the results of the group work (3' per group, 1.5' per topic).
