



Enhancing labour mobility for EU enlargement economies: the role of ESCO 24 and 25 June 2025 Turin, Italy

Introduction

The European Training Foundation (ETF) and the Regional Cooperation Council's (RCC) Employment and Social Affairs Platform Project 3 (ESAP 3) are organizing a two-day capacity building event dedicated to the enlargement economies to explore the use of the European Classification of Skills, Competences, Qualifications and Occupations (ESCO).

The event is placed within the context of labour and skills mobility and EU accession efforts in the area of free movement of workers, notably in relation to EU tools such as EURES and Europass, as well as recent policy priorities set out in the Union of skills - European Commission.

The event aims to showcase different use cases of ESCO on job-matching, labour market analysis and education and training topics. It is designed to be participatory, facilitating the sharing of experiences among stakeholders and fostering engaging discussions about the requirements for using ESCO in the participating countries.

Next to the on-site event in Turin, the ETF and RCC will organise a series of webinars on ESCO to provide an overview of its development and collect specific questions, needs and future priorities of the participating countries.
