BACKGROUND

In a world rapidly transformed by digitalisation and the pressing need for sustainability, industries are evolving at an unprecedented pace. This shift demands **fresh skill sets and innovative training models**—and **at the forefront of this transformation are the Centres of Vocational Excellence (CoVEs)**. CoVEs are **leading the way** in preparing learners to thrive in the digital and green transitions.

The ETF Network for Excellence (ENE) has undertaken various activities over the past three years in the domain of **digitalisation of education**. The ENE sub-initiative on digital excellence, known as DIGI ENE, is composed of Centres of Excellence that demonstrate noteworthy practices in digital teaching and learning. These centres are also dedicated to ongoing enhancement in this field through diverse peer learning activities with other members. ETF is giving the opportunity to the DIGI ENE members to present a collection of best practices at the **Forum of Vocational Excellence**, and to attend a peer learning visit to relevant key stakeholders in Denmark.

The fourth **Forum on Vocational Excellence** is organised in Kolding, Denmark, from 8 until 10 September 2025. The event creates a platform for learning for the whole Community of Practice of CoVEs. One of the main goals is to provide matchmaking opportunities between the CoVEs, both nationally and internationally.

After the Forum, the DIGI ENE group will leave Kolding and move to Copenhagen, and attend a study visit to **leading VET actors and institutions** in innovative teaching and learning.

The peer learning visit will provide an immersive experience to the participants, facilitating **networking** with other practitioners; encouraging **reflection** on the individual practices and needs and should support knowledge transfer.
