## MAPPING OF INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS' ROLE IN THE COUNTRIES OF INTEREST OF THE ETF- SURVEY AND INTERVIEWS

#### **Purpose of the processing**

Within the specific scope of a mapping and analysis of International Financial Institutions' role in some countries of interest that ETF is conducting, the purpose to collect and process personal data is limited to:

- 1) administer a survey (i.e. to send the survey link via email, send reminders to persons who did not respond to the survey..)
- 2) conduct semi-structured interviews with a limited number of key informants

#### **Legal basis**

The legal basis for the processing operations of personal data is Regulation No. 1339/2008 establishing the European Training Foundation (Recast), article 2, functions, (f).

#### **Personal data**

Contact details (function/job title, first name, last name, name of organisation, e-mail address, telephone number) of the persons receiving invitation to the survey and of the persons invited for an interview

#### **Recipients of the personal data**

For the purpose detailed above, access to personal data is provided to the following processing entities:

- The ETF project team
- Expert contracted through ETF framework contract for the purpose of the assignment subject to data protection clauses

### **Data retention**

The survey and its results in the survey tool will be destroyed after the conclusion of the survey. Contracted expert will keep the raw data for the duration of the assignment, up to the delivery of the final report, after which they will be eliminated.

Exported survey data used by the ETF project team will be retained on ETF systems for 2 years after conclusion of the assignment and will not be shared to third parties. ETF will keep report(s) with aggregated and anonymous data for unlimited period for historical / research purposes.

Personal data of the persons interviewed will be retained by the ETF project team until conclusion of the assignment.

### **Right of access, rectification or erasure, restriction, objection**

Any request to access, rectify or erase personal data, or to restrict or object or withdraw consent to the processing of personal data shall be addressed in writing to [Thierry.Foubert@etf.europa.eu](mailto:Thierry.Foubert@etf.europa.eu) giving details of the request.
