The **ETF Community for Innovative Educators** has been working since 2022 to foster the promotion, discussion, and adoption of innovative teaching and learning practices among teachers, trainers, and education professionals. With a mission to empower educators to help each other innovate, the community has become a vibrant space for collaboration and experimentation, with more than 1600 members, 40 Ambassadors and many activities in several countries.

Over the past two years, the community has worked through the implementation of **thematic New Learning Clubs**, groups of educators, managers, and experts from different countries that collaborate to explore a specific theme related to learning innovation, such as STEAM Education, Teaching with AI, Teachers Professional Development.

During the webinar, the main results of the clubs will be presented and used to reflect together on lessons learned, personal growth stories, and the overall impact of the community journey. Also, the webinar will focus on exploring ideas for the community in 2026, continuing collaboration and sustaining the momentum of innovation in education, and will end with the launch of the new ETF Competition on Innovative Practices on integrated key competencies.
