Dissemination webinar — Study on the digital competence of teachers in Ukraine

SUMMARY:

The European Training Foundation (ETF), in partnership with the Directorate-General for Education, Youth, Sport, and Culture (DG EAC) of the European Commission, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine; and the Ministry of Digital Transformation of Ukraine, launched in 2025 a study on the digital competence of secondary teachers in Ukraine, aiming to provide valuable insights of teachers' perceptions of their own digital competences, identify common strengths and development needs, and generate recommendations to support systemic improvement and a regular use of the tool by local and national stakeholders and policymakers.

The study in a nutshell

More than 400 schools and 8,000 teachers in Ukraine took part in the study.

Teachers involved in the study have been engaged in a self-reflection process using the European Commission's SELFIE for TEACHERS tool. Each participant received an immediate personal feedback report, including suggestions to improve their digital competences according to their own teaching context and subject area.

Additionally, **each participating school has received a school report** with aggregated anonymised data for their teachers to help shape teacher professional development initiatives according to identified needs. Furthermore, this report enables schools to track and analyse how teachers' digital competence needs change and develop over time.

Finally, **anonymised results were analysed by experts at regional and national levels** to develop new knowledge in support of evidence-informed teacher professional learning and digital education policies at local and national levels.

Experts also reviewed and updated the study's methodology, pinpointing factors that help or hinder **Ukraine's ability to regularly use the tool** in autonomy by both national and local authorities or foster a use of the tool at the school level.

Purpose of the dissemination event

We are now ready to present the **preliminary findings** of the national results and draft policy messages in this workshop, which is intended to:

- Share and discuss the **key findings** emerging from the self-assessment of over 8,000 teachers;
- Shape relevant **policy messages** for national and local policymakers
- Reflect on **conditions for a regular and coordinated use** of the tool in the country
