- Name, surname and e-mail address. For specific training courses, additional information might be needed (e.g. date and place of birth, fiscal code, private address).

Recipients of the personal data

For the purpose detailed above, access to personal data is provided to the following processing entities:

- Internal recipients are the L&D Officer(s), Managers, Director
- External recipients are the contractors organising/providing training. In the case of firefighting / first aid trainings, data are provided to local authorities for the inscription of data subjects in relevant registers.
