Scope of the procedure:

The main objective of the requested service is to support the ETF in setting-up and facilitating a peer learning partnership in the thematic area 'Going Green', in particular, greening of teaching and learning.

The partnership will enable CoVEs to learn from one another and to address their own development collaboratively through thematic actions.

The selected tenderer will design and facilitate the implementation of a peer review of participating CoVEs on their green responses in vocational and education training programmes, to support CoVEs in elaboration of Action Maps for development, to provide recommendations and actions for peer learning and to facilitate thematic peer learning actions.

Type of contract: Fixed contract service in phases

Selection criteria - technical and professional capacity requested to the economic operator:

Experience in implementing similar services in the past three years, including:

- Experience in developing institutional capacities of VET providers through development actions

- Experience in reviewing occupational profiles and qualifications to include green skills, greening of VET curricula, green skills delivery, teachers training for green competencies
- Experience in design of institutional analyses, peer reviews and surveys of VET providers and their ability to adapt to the SDGs and introduce green skills in existing and new curricula.
- Experience to design and manage peer learning, practice exchange, community of practices of VET providers.
