Purpose of the processing

Legal basis

The legal basis for the processing operations of personal data are the ETF Building Security Policy (ETF/18/DEC/010) and the ETF Health and Safety Policy (ETF/16/DEC/007).

Personal data

Personal data concerned are:

- Crisis management team members: Name, private telephone number and email address
- Crisis subjects and other actors: Name and any other data needed for the crisis management (e.g. personal ID, names of relatives to be contacted etc.)

Recipients of the personal data

For the purpose detailed above, access to personal data is provided to the following processing entities:

• Crisis Management Team, and any other actors involved on a need-to-know-basis.

Transfer to third countries/international organisations

Data retention

Data collected will be retained:

- For the crisis management team: as long as the person is member of the team
- For the management of the crisis: two years after complete closure of the event

Right of access, rectification or erasure, restriction, objection
