Purpose of the processing

The purpose of collecting personal data of ETF Network for Excellence's members is to:

- facilitate possible synergies and create an international network for continuous exchange of professional purposes and practice among centres of excellence at local, national or international level;
- develop partnerships between COVEs in different countries, including coaching sessions, peer learning visits, peer reviews and events leading to studies, reports, etc.;
- participate also in other projects and events managed by ETF and/or by other Networks of excellence with whom ETF cooperates (e.g. Skillman);
- Development and improvement of tools produced by the Network (e.g self-assessment tool);
- Inform about EU instruments and tools;
- Publish reports and studies containing aggregated data on centres of vocational excellence who are members of ETF Network for Excellence.

Legal basis

Regulation No. 1339/2008 establishing the European Training Foundation (Recast), Article 2

Personal data

Personal data concern name, surname, phone number, e-mail account.

Provision of these data is mandatory for being part of ENE for COVEs.

Personal data may also be collected and processed for the following other purposes:

1. **For sharing with other members of the ENE for COVEs network**, ETF staff, other networks or centres of vocational excellence or experts in the field working within ETF projects. The member can choose to share this information by ticking the corresponding box on the form.
2. **For registration in the ETF stakeholders` database for future contact purposes related to ETF`s activities**, the member can choose to share this information by ticking the corresponding box on the form.

Recipients of the personal data

Data retention

Data are kept for three years from the last registered access, after which the profile including all data, will be deleted.

Right of access, rectification or erasure, restriction, objection, withdraw consent

Right to lodge complaint
