Purpose of the processing

The purpose of the processing is to manage the ISATCOVE framework, to identify persons interested in using ISATCOVE self-assessment tool, to process registration requests for the tool, to manage the use of the tool, and to provide support services to the users of the tool and the framework.

Legal basis

The legal basis for the processing operations of personal data is Regulation No. 1339/2008 establishing the European Training Foundation (Recast), article 2.

Personal data

Personal data concerned are:

- Contact detail email address of individual
- Name of organisation
- Position in organisation
- Country of organisation

Recipients of the personal data

For the purpose detailed above, access to personal data is provided to the following processing entities:

- The ETF project team performing the study
- The moderator of the ISATCOVE tool

• Contracted agents, for example assessors or coaches, who will have short-term access and contractually respect data protection clauses.

Further information

Data retention

Personal data collected in the ISATCOVE tool, hosted on ETF servers, will be retained for the duration of the project after which they will be deleted.

Personal data collected in related surveys (e.g. expression of interest) on the www.ec.europa.eu/eusurvey servers, will be retained for the duration of the project after which they will be deleted.

Exported data used by the ETF project team will be retained on ETF servers for 5 years after conclusion of the project by the ETF team.

Right of access, rectification or erasure, restriction, objection

Any request to access, rectify or erase personal data, or to restrict or object or withdraw consent to the processing of personal data shall be addressed in writing to the lntvE@etf.europa.eu giving details of the request.

Right to lodge complaint
