SUMMARY

The Republic of North Macedonia has taken several initiatives to support the development of digital skills and foster the use of digital technologies in education and training including, for example, the Strategy for Education 2018-2025, the VET Strategy 2013-2020 and the Law for Adult Education (2008).

In this context and in line with the co-operation between the Republic of North Macedonia and the European Training Foundation¹ (ETF) for 2019, the aim of this event is to launch a pilot of SELFIE² in a set of schools in the Republic of North Macedonia.

SELFIE is a tool developed by the Joint Research Centre of the European Commission³ that aims to support the innovative use of digital technologies in teaching and learning in primary schools and secondary general and vocational schools, and support the development of digital competence of learners.

SELFIE can guides schools in a self-reflection process on their progress towards comprehensive integration and effective deployment of digital technologies into teaching, learning and student assessment.

At school level, SELFIE uses questionnaires to collect the views of school leaders, teachers and students, on anonymous and voluntary basis. It explores six areas, namely leadership, infrastructure and equipment, continuing professional development, teaching and learning, assessment practices and student digital competence and results are collected in paper-less interactive report.

At system level, SELFIE offers, through anonymous aggregated data, an overview of the digital readiness of the school system in the Republic of North Macedonia.

The SELFIE project in the Republic of North Macedonia is coordinated by Ms Nadica Kostoska (nadica.kostoska@mon.gov.mk) with the support of the Joint Research Centre (JRC - European Commission) and of the European Training Foundation (ETF).

Objectives of the event:

- Launch of a pilot of SELFIE in the Republic of North Macedonia, involving a set of primary schools and secondary general and vocational schools selected by the Ministry of Education;
- Train the Continuing Professional Development (CPD), Information, and Communication Technology (ICT) school coordinators of pilot schools to cover the role of *SELFIE school coordinator*.

Together with the school managers, CPD and ICT coordinators of the pilot schools, the event will see the participation of relevant national stakeholders.

This event and the subsequent results of pilot of SELFIE (from 17/05 to 07/06) will inform the Ministry of Education and Science on the next steps with SELFIE towards a general adoption.
