SUMMARY

The Torino Process is an evidence-informed analysis of Human Capital Development issues and VET policies responses in the ETF partner countries. The process, launched by the ETF for the first time in 2010, enters in its fifth round of implementation that will be completed in the period 2019-2020.

The objectives of this first workshop are the following:

- To get familiar with the TRP 2018/19 objectives and strategic orientations;
- To present and familiarise with the TRP National Reporting Framework - NRF (framework of analysis) and clarify any questions on the NRF
- To present the ETF assessment
