SUMMARY

The Torino Process is an evidence-informed analysis of Human Capital Development issues and Vocational Education and Training (VET) policies' responses in the ETF partner countries. The process, launched by the ETF for the first time in 2010, enters in its fifth round of implementation that will be completed in the period 2018-2020.

Israel participated in the Torino process since 2010 adopting a self-assessment approach for the conduct of the discussions and drafting of the reports.

The objective of this launch workshop is to present the Torino process 2018-20 strategic orientations and to define specific policy relevance and added value of the Torino Process in Israel.
