Torino Process 2018-2020 Dissemination meeting – Key findings and recommendations of National report and ETF assessment, 5 November 2019, Chisinau, Moldova

Main objective/s

Following the preparation of the national report, based on the National Reporting Framework, and of the ETF assessment, this workshop will have the primary objective to present and disseminate key findings and recommendations, representing the main outcomes of the process.

Specific objectives of the workshop are the following

- Share with participants the key findings and recommendations of the National Report (based on NRF) and of the ETF assessment
- Discuss in detail identified recommendations
- Identify and agree specific actions to address the recommendations (both short quick-wins and longterm actions)

Background

The Republic of Moldova participated in the Torino process since 2010 and in 2016, chose to take full responsibility of the Torino process and produced the report in a self-assessment methodology. Again in 2019 the drafting of the National Report has been done by an inter-stakeholders working group under the leadership of the Ministry of Education, Culture and research.

SHORT DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT

The event has been structured around two main moments. In the first one, the Ministry of Education and the ETF presented the two reports (National Report and ETF assessment) and collected the reactions from the participants. IN the second one the participants worked together to formulate specific actions to address the recommendations of the ETF assessment.

KEY OUTCOMES/CONCLUSIONS

The key outcome of the meeting has been a number of clarifications, opinions and corrections as well as a set of proposed actions to address the recommendations put forward in the ETF assessment.

The proposed acitons address the two key human capital development issues identified in the Etf assessment:

- Depletion of human capital due to migration
- Exclusion of youth from employment and education opportunities
