Next steps for Entrepreneurial Learning in Bosnia and Herzegovina, Sarajevo, 4-5 July 2019

Main objectives

- Review of activities in entrepreneurial learning in BiH since 2016
- Identify new priorities on entrepreneurial learning developments in BiH education systems
- Share good practices on entrepreneurship developments from schools taking part in ELES Programme

Background

A deliverable from the 2019 work programme of the Ministry of Civil Affairs was the elaboration of state-wide priorities for entrepreneurial learning following. A recent assessment of the Small Business Act for Europe had recommended that an earlier strategy which had expired in 2016 should be updated.

More developed issues for entrepreneurship key competence addressed with ETF support in 2018 provided the good basis for a working group planned for 4-5 July in Sarajevo.

SHORT DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT

The workshop was attended by representatives from the Ministry of Civil Affairs, Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Republika Srpska and Brcko District, and comprised:

- a review of entrepreneurship developments at a number of schools since the completion of an EU support programme and presentation of good practices from the participating schools;
- breakout groups which addressed core pillars of a future BiH priorities paper for entrepreneurial learning: a) entrepreneurship key competence in elementary, secondary and vocational education, b) teacher training and engagement of parents and teachers, c) entrepreneurship on higher education and adult learning, d) monitoring, reporting and evaluation.

KEY OUTCOMES/CONCLUSIONS

- Elaboration of first draft of the priorities paper (ENG, HR) and getting feedback from working group;
- Finalisation of the Paper and translation into Bosnian and Cyrillic languages.

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
