



Governing Board Decision for empowering the ETF Director to request the Commission's agreement to the non-application of Commission rules on "Contract Staff"

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE ETF,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials ('Staff Regulations') and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union ('CEOS') laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68¹, and in particular Article 110(2) thereof,

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EC) n° 1339/2008 of 16 December 2008 establishing a European Training Foundation (recast)², and in particular article 21 thereof,

Having regard to Communication C(2014) 6543 final of 26 September 2014 from Vice-President Šefčovič to the Commission on the guidelines on the implementation of Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations with regard to the implementing rules applicable in the agencies, and in particular Point 2.B thereof,

Having regard to the Commission Decision C(2017) 6760 on the general provisions for implementing Article 79(2) of the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union, governing the conditions of employment of contract staff employed by the Commission, entering into force on 1st November 2017:

Having regard to the fact that Agencies differ from the Commission, particularly as regards the nature of their staff and structure,

Having regard to the fact that the Commission's services, with the assistance of the Standing Working Party, should draft model decisions in this area more adapted to the agencies peculiarities,

After consulting the ETF Staff Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING DECISION

Article 1

The ETF Director is empowered to request the Commission's agreement to the non-application of the following Commission decision:

- C(2017) 6760 on the general provisions for implementing Article 79(2) of the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union, governing the conditions of employment of contract staff employed by the Commission

Article 2

This decision shall take effect on the day of its signature.
